**3. DONATIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND:** In the Jan.-Feb 2023 Bulletin, we published our total expenses for 2021, with a breakdown of some of the operating expenses versus how much money we receive from membership. There was a great gap between membership income and expenses (including the expenses incurred from our Projects - Holiday Troop Support, All American Adventure, awards to Troopers, support to deployed Troopers, and funding to support Troopers and families in extraordinary circumstances).

So, you might ask "where do we get the money to do all this?" The answer is simple, but not easy to do. We work hard at donations. We work very hard at bringing in donations, and to be truthful, most of our members do not give anything annually to help us complete our mission, and to support the Troopers of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division. Many Members feel that being a Member of the Association is about having a membership card and not about being a supportive member of the Association and the Division.

There are Members and Chapters that do a great job supporting our mission and our projects, however, many have not supported the Association in years. We call this our Association, but many are not helping to ensure its success. We need the support of our members – we need you. Support your 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association now. Show our Troopers that you care.

We are not asking for large amounts of funds, but if every Member gave even 10 a year it would go a long way toward the success of the Association. We are a 501(c) non-profit organization and your contribution is tax-deductible within the limits prescribed by law.

- 4. <u>PAYMENT OF CHAPTER PORTION OF MEMBERSHIP DUES (CHAPTER REFUNDS)</u>: This is the portion of membership dues received directly by the National Office, and to be paid to the Chapter selected by the member upon registration, as per the Association By-laws, Article II-Membership, Section 1, Paragraph E, Subparagraph 1, Items a-c, for. These refunds will be calculated and a list of refunds due will be sent to the related Chapters next week. If there are no issues with the published list we will begin distributing the funds.
- 5. <u>NATIONAL DIRECTOR NOMINATIONS</u>: If you want to help shape our Association, then make a difference by running for National Director. Chapter nominations for National Directors must be received at the National office by 1 June 2023, either by mail or email. We will notify your Chapter when it is received. Chapter nominations must be certified by the Chapter Chairperson and must be in compliance with Article V of the Association By-Laws (By-Laws can be viewed at our website at: <u>http://www.82ndairborneassociation.org/forms-and-resources.html</u>)





Nominations should include a brief description, 4-5 sentences, about the nominee. Please include the nominee's qualifications, past accomplishments, as well as what the nominee proposes to do for the Association, if elected.

- 6. <u>CHAPTER DELEGATES TO AAW AND 2023 CONVENTION</u>: As per the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association By-Laws, Article IV, Section 7, the Chapter Chairman or a designated representative must attend Delegate meetings of the Association. Chapter Officers are reminded to designate their Delegate(s) to attend AAW by 1 May 2023 and the Convention by 20 July 2022. If you are unable to send a delegate you must receive an excusal from the Association President. To receive an excusal, you can send a request for excusal to the National Office and we will submit to the President for approval. Chapter Officers are reminded to designate their Delegate(s) to attend AAW by 1 May 2023 and the Convention by 20 July 2023.   - **b.** <u>Recognition of the Jumpmaster, NCO, and Trooper of the Year:</u> Every year our Association recognizes the accomplishments of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Divisions Jumpmaster, Non-Commissioned Officer, and Trooper of the Year at our annual dinner during AAW. On the final evening of AAW, the Leadership and Troopers of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division join the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association Members as we present these outstanding Troopers with awards to recognize their accomplishments (accomplished through Association and corporate donations).





c. <u>All American Adventure 2023</u>: The plan is to send twenty 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Troopers on a



4-day resiliency trip to the Catskill Mountains for fishing, hiking, biking and numerous other activities. Aimed at helping Troopers in reintegration after deployment, this project uses donations from Association Members and Chapters, and Corporate sponsorship to accomplish this project. This trip usually takes place in June, provided we are able to secure funding for our Troopers. - 12. <u>IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT FOR CHAPTERS</u>: Chapters need to be cautious when using images, cartoons, etc., that are found on the internet, on your websites, newsletters, etc. If it has a copyright, you can be leaving yourselves open to litigation. This has happened to a Chapter recently and we hope to avoid other Chapters from having to deal with this issue. Always search to ensure items do not have a copyright prior to using.
- 13. <u>CHAPTER REQUIREMENTS</u>: There are required Chapter documents that must be sent to the National Office. All required reports are listed in this bulletin and are referenced as REQUIRED. **Required Chapter documents are** *not optional* **and are required for the Chapters to maintain their non-profit 501(c)4 status**. Any Chapter that does not submit the required documents will be reported to the Board of Directors, and be subject to closure by the Board of Directors. There are only a few documents required to be submitted every year by the Chapter Chairman, and they must be completed. *We have created a standard form for all required annual reports. Please use only that form, which was emailed to your Chapter email in January 2023 and is available on our website:*

<u>https://82ndairborneassociation.org/resources.html</u>). If the necessary information is not included in the reports or the standardized reports are not used, the Chapter will be asked to resubmit with the required information or on the correct form.

- 14. <u>2023 CHAPTER OFFICERS (*REQUIRED*)</u>: DEADLINE: 1 February 2023. PAST DUE. The list of the Chapter Officers that will be serving in the year of 2023 should include, name, position and contact information. *If your Chapter elects Officers within the year of 2023, you must notify the National Office immediately so that we can update our records*. We have created a standard form (click or go to link for form: <u>https://82ndairborneassociation.org/resources.html</u>). Please use only that form. These documents must be submitted every year whether there are changes or not.
- 15. <u>2022/2023 CHAPTER ACTIVITIES REPORTS (REQUIRED)</u>: DEADLINE: 1 February 2023. PAST DUE. Per the Association By-Laws, "a report of the dates and places of all meetings and activities held or sponsored by the Chapter" throughout the 2022 year, and a "tentative" schedule of the Chapter's meetings and activities for 2023, is a requirement. We have created a standard form (click or go to the link for form: <u>https://82ndairborneassociation.org/resources.html</u>). Please use only that format.
- 16. <u>2022 CHAPTER FINANCIAL STATEMENTS (*REQUIRED*)</u>: DEADLINE: 10 April 2023. 2022 Chapter Financial Statements, which are *required* to be furnished by all Association, have been emailed to the Chapter email in January 2023. Your financial statements are due to the National Office by 10 April 2023. If your Financial Statement is not received by 10 April 2023, you must file separately. NO EXCEPTIONS. Any financial reports not received by this date will need to be filed by the chapter separately, and at the cost of the chapter. Chapters that fail to file tax returns with the IRS are subject to having the Board of Directors remove their Charter, and close the Chapter. If your Chapter files separately, you must notify the National Office on Chapter letterhead signed by the Chapter Chairman, stating that the Chapter has filed their taxes separately from the Association. The financial statements can be emailed to execsec@82ndairborneassociation.org or mailed to the office. Any Chapter not following these procedures are liable to have their Chapter Charter removed.
